Cut a picture of three famous personalities each. Paste them in your scrap book and write 7-8 adjectives for each one of them. (To be done in a scrap book)

5. Writing

Paste one photograph of a place you visited during summer vacation and write a paragraph on it. (To be done in a scrap book)

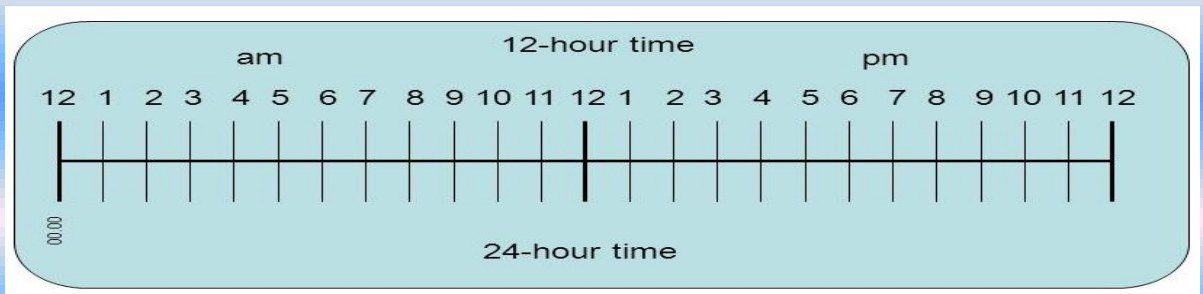
6-व्याकरण पुस्तक से मुहावरे,पर्यायवाची शब्द याद करें ।
