- Making a Herbarium:

A Herbarium is a collection of dried and pressed plants or leaves. For hundreds of years, scientists and plant lovers have preserved dried plants for study in Herbarium to use the data associated with it for scientific study.

### Instructions:

- (1) Collect 5 leaves of different plants.
- (2) Dry all the leaves by placing them in between the pages.
- (3) Set it aside for 8-10 days to let the leaves dry.
- (4) Once the leaves are dry you are ready to compile your Herbarium pages.
- (5) Using a narrow piece of tape, secure each leaf on paper.
- (6) Write the following details of each leaf
  - (a) Name of the plant
  - (b) Does the plant have any nutritional qualities?
